Student Survey Results

Redeemer University Student Senate

Goal: This survey was conducted to gain the student's feedback on Student Senate run events, student representation, and various other topics which can be implemented to create improvements within the Student Senate.

Background:

Student Senate is always working to improve our clubs, activities and events, seeking to ensure that we are providing students with the best possible experience at Redeemer. To discover more ways that we can represent the student body, we decided to create a survey to gain their feedback on the Student Senate. Taking the time to receive student feedback is important in planning for future years of the Student Senate and gaining useful information to plan and improve what we do as a Student Senate. The questions on this survey were designed to cover a wide variety of topics so that each area of the Student Senate would receive relevant feedback regarding what should be continued and what could be improved.

Survey Method:


This survey was targeted to all students enrolled at Redeemer. Student Senate developed survey questions on a broad range of topics regarding food services, the rec centre, student representation, clubs, activities and publication clubs, among other areas. After forming this survey, it was posted on the Redeemer App and Student Senate social media, and was emailed to all students. The survey was open from Friday, February 12 until Friday, February 19 to allow students time to take part in the survey. There was also a reward offered as an incentive to fill out this survey.

217 students, about 25% of students enrolled at Redeemer, completed the survey.

Survey Results & Interpretation:


This survey consisted of 25 questions, both multiple choice and short answer questions. The results of the questions are as follows:

Q1: What year are you in?





Interpretation: Question 2 helps Student Senate to determine the best way to contact students. Based on this information, email is the best way to contact students. This also shows areas where Senate could improve communication, such as making Instagram more effective and exploring the possibility of a biweekly email or newsletter from the Student Senate.





Q3: How informed do you think you are on Student Senate projects?

Q4: How well do you think that Student Senate represents you? Why?

This question received a wide range of answers, between students who believe that Senate does a good job at representing them, students who are unsure because they are unaware of what Senate does, and students who believe that Senate does not represent them. These answers indicated that the surveys sent out regarding reading break and other general topics give students a better sense that their opinions are valued and heard by Student Senate. Other students are unaware of what we do as a Senate, and are unable to comment on this question. A few students stated that there is a need for representation of commuter students, or that senators are not "interacting a lot with students as well as not representing all that Redeemer has to offer."

Interpretation: Questions 3 and 4 show the need for better communication from Senate to increase awareness about our events, activities and jobs as a whole.





Q6: Is there something that would hold you back from running for a Student Senate position? What is it?




Q7: How would you rate the quality and convenience of food services?

Q8: How would you rate the quality and accessibility of the Rec Centre?




Q9: What kind of recreational spaces do you think are missing at Redeemer or what kind of recreational spaces would you like to see more of?

This is important for community building and provides a space for students to relax and get together outside of the dorms and the academic building. Many students also suggested that there is a need for an increased space for commuter students.



Q11: Are you aware of where your Student Senate Fees are spent on?

Interpretation: Question 11 shows that not many people are aware of what student fees are spent on. It is important to make sure that information stays accessible to students, which could perhaps be done through a post on our instagram page showing students what their fees are spent on (operational costs, clubs, activities, events and other areas).

Q12: Are there any capital projects that you would like Student Senate to invest in? What are they?

Students suggested a variety of answers: a pool, increased recreational space, improved food services, increased capacity of the gym, and more club meeting spaces.

Interpretation: Question 12 provides great insight into what students would like to see at Redeemer in the future. Some of these ideas include: a pool, increased recreational space, and improving food services.

Q14: Comment on your experience participating in Redeemer Clubs.


Students shared that clubs are great for building community and forming relationships with other students who have similar interests. This is shown to be a great way to get involved at Redeemer.



Q16: Do you read the Crown online?



Q17: How would you rate the quality of the Crown?




Q18: Have you ever submitted your work to the Crown or Quest?



Q19: How would you rate the quality of the Yearbook?




Q20: Would you prefer a paper or online copy of the Yearbook?

Q23: What do you think about the current Spiritual Events at Redeemer (ie. Hotspot)?



Q24: Do you have any suggestions for how spiritual life at Redeemer could be improved?

Suggestions include small groups with students from different dorms/households, increased number of events, and events that online students are able to participate in.

Interpretation: Questions 16 to 24 are more specific to certain members of senate or publication clubs, and this information has been sent to them to allow them to improve their events or club to allow more students to benefit from what they offer.

Interpretation: Question 25 was added to gain feedback regarding the decision to move graduation online. This was helpful during meetings with members of the administration, and to gain an understanding of the student's perspective and opinion on this decision.
